- What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- What are the main responsibilities in your current role?
- What do you most enjoy about your current role?
- Do you enjoy working as an individual or part of a team?
- Can you describe a time when you've faced a difficult challenge and how you overcame it?
- What interested you in this position?
- What skills could you bring to this position?
- Why do you want to leave your current company and role?
- Do you have any questions for us?
